'When I Die' is a helpful resource in which to record all the 'other' stuff that may not be recorded in your will, such as personal identification information (required for death certificate), contact details and how to notify family, friends and professionals, preference for body disposal, funeral/memorial service, financial (bank accounts, income, business and property ownership), memberships, subscriptions, insurances, distribution of items not included in your will, on-line registrations etc.

The 'When I Die' workbook puts everything in one place and is designed to assist your family, legal professional and executor with the administration of your estate. Copies of 'When I Die' will be for sale at \$25 each, with payment by cash or bank deposit.

Our second guest speaker is Alysha Macaulay from 'Grief to Peace'. Alysha is a compassionate end-of-life doula who is deeply committed to supporting those in the community who may be facing life-limiting diagnoses or disease. Alysha offers spiritual, physical, practical and logistical guidance through their unique journeys, whether it be toward remission, continued treatment, or peaceful end-of-life care.

Alysha is also a visionary funeral celebrant. With a profound understanding of love and loss, she designs bespoke tributes that honour cherished memories and ignite a renewed passion for living a life of purpose.
